



Our social groups provide students the opportunity to learn the skills that underlie true social understanding via direct instruction, role play, videotaping with structured feedback, cognitive modeling and activities to develop and improve relatedness. Application and generalization with families, schools and other providers is fostered by providing weekly visual supports and information related to skills being emphasized, weekly generalization "assignments" through which students are asked to complete generalization activities and report back to the group and weekly parent visits to the group where students have the opportunity to "teach" skills being emphasized to family members such that they can be reinforced in other settings. Groups are kept small with 2-6 students in attendance.
